- Third Sector organisations/community groups require to have a constitution and appropriate governance and financial arrangements in place, proportionate to the value of the application.

HOPEFULLY, THUS INSPIRED, THE PUPILS WILL BE BETTER MOTIVATED AS THEY START SECONDARY EDUCATION LOOKING FORWARD TO A LIFE OF FULFILLING AND REWARDING EMPLOYMENT AHEAD, OUT OF POVERTY AND DEPENDENCY.
- OVER THE LAST 3 YEARS, OVER 800 P7 PUPILS HAVE BENEFITTED FROM THESE ENCOUNTERS WITH THESE PROFESSIONAL, MANY OF WHOM THEMSELVES HAD DIFFICULT STARTS IN THEIR LIVES, BUT HAVE NOW BECOME LEADERS IN THEIR CHOSEN CAREERS, AND ENTHUSIASTICALLY WANT TO RETURN EACH YEAR TO SHARE THEIR LIFE EXPERIENCES.
- THE COSTS INCREASE EACH YEAR, IN PARTICULAR THE COSTS OF TRANSPORTING THE CHILDREN TO AND FROM THE AYR TOWN HALL WHERE THE EVENT IS HELD; WE HAVE INCREASED THE NUMBER OF PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS TO 9 AND ARE CONSIDERING A FURTHER INCREASE IN 2026
- ALL CAREER REPS GIVE FREELY OF THEIR TIME, AND DO NOT ASK FOR TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT ETC. ADDITIONAL COSTS INCLUDE RENT OF THE HALL (THOUGH WE ARE VERY GRATEFUL THAT SAC HAVE WAIVED THIS CHARGE IN RECENT YEARS). REFRESHMENTS FOR THOSE ATTENDING FOR THE DAY ARE PROVIDED.
