What community will this project be delivered in and what communities will benefit?

This project will be delivered in Maybole, South Ayrshire, where the Maybole Women's Group meets weekly. The group provides a safe and supportive space for women from the local area to connect, share experiences, and build confidence.

The primary beneficiaries will be women living in and around Maybole, many of whom face barriers such as social isolation, mental health challenges, and limited access to cultural experiences. By offering a theatre day trip, we aim to uplift these individuals and strengthen their sense of belonging.

Wider communities across North Carrick—including Kirkoswald, Dunure, Crosshill, and surrounding villages—may also benefit indirectly, as participants return with renewed confidence, stronger social ties, and increased engagement in local activities. The project fosters inclusion, well-being, and community spirit across the region.

Please provide information you have about the need and support for the project, eg community consultation

The need for this project has emerged directly from the voices of the women in our group. Through regular discussions at our weekly meetings in Maybole Library, members have expressed a strong desire for shared experiences beyond the local area, particularly cultural outings that foster connection and joy. Many have never attended a live theatre performance, and the idea of a day/evening trip was met with enthusiasm and emotional support from the group.

Our approach is rooted in community-led decision-making. Activities are chosen by the women themselves, with support from volunteers who help organise and deliver what the woman within the group wants. This ensures the project reflects genuine interest and need, rather than top-down planning.

We also work closely with Thriving Communities, who provide space and guidance, and have helped us grow steadily in numbers. Word-of-mouth and peer encouragement have been key to our success, showing that the group is trusted and valued locally.

The proposed theatre trip is not just a day/evening out, it's a response to isolation, anxiety, and a lack of access to cultural life. It's backed by the women's voices, supported by local networks, and designed to uplift and empower.
