Outline of Proposal	
To convert the existing Shed which is not being used into a designated IT hub consisting workstations to house 8/10 Laptops, 2 printers and Projection Screen for the purposes of offering individuals of all ages the opportunity of learning new Information Technology skills and to facilitate a need for Internet access and printing facilities which might not be readily available at home. This will facilitate a provision of IT access for the community as and when required for people who do not have access to these facilities. A booking system can be utilised as and when required.	

The proposal would be to offer free IT classes to those requiring familiarisation of laptops and allied applications including Word Processing and Spreadsheet basic skills as well as Internet use and access to allied (useful) applications. An IT Hub would allow us to teach these skills up to 10 individuals up at a time It will allow the possibility of IT use for the wider community but more importantly will allow a very useful facility for the community.
