а	Project Title Hosiery Park Pavilion Acquisition	
b	About Your Project	
	The project is to fund the acquisition of the Hosiery Park Pavilion, Brodie Avenue, Troon by a Community Asset Transfer from South Ayrshire Council for use as a Men's Shed.	





The purpose of our Men's Shed is to provide recreational facilities and advance the social needs, health and well being of men of all ages and backgrounds living in Troon and surrounding areas. Troon Men's Shed was established in April 2024 and has a growing membership with 75 members as at 30 April 2025.

Fortnightly social meetings are currently held in The Lighthouse Christian Centre in Ailsa Road, Troon where tea and coffee are provided and guest speakers such as Prostate Scotland, Scottish Men's Shed Association, Fishermen's Mission, Troon Community Council, Troon Club 41 have given talks.

NHS Ayrshire and Arran have held an ageing well Functional Fitness MOT. Visits have taken place to UPM Caledonian Paper Mill and the Scottish Maritime Museum in Irvine.

Our members have volunteered to help out at community events in Troon; Wintertainment, Troon Round Table Fireworks and Santa Float.

We are currently (April 2025) assisting Ayrshire Cancer Support with getting their new Ayr centre ready by moving items from storage, and assembling desks, tables, cupboards, sofas, chairs, putting up pictures and providing other volunteer assistance.


The acquisition of the Hosiery Park Pavilion will enable us to meet more regularly and undertake practical workshop activities which we are unable to do in a hired meeting hall.

A Stage 1 Community Asset Transfer Request was submitted to South Ayrshire Council in November 2024 and the Stage 2 request is currently being prepared, with a target date to submit of 31 May 2025.

The Hosiery Park Pavilion building is in poor condition as it has been unused for several years, and once acquired would be repaired and converted into a suitable facility comprising of an activity workshop area where woodworking and other similar practical activities can be undertaken, and a separate multi-use social space.










	The Hosiery Park Pavilion has been disused for a number of years and requires repairs undertaken as detailed in a Condition Survey Report undertaken by South Ayrshire Council in March 2023. As part of our Stage 2 Community Asset Transfer request we will be applying for an Advancing Community Assets Fund Capital Grant for necessary repairs.
	The main areas of the building currently consists of changing rooms, toilets and communal showers. The building would require to be converted to make it suitable for use as a Men's Shed. The former shower and large toilet areas would be used as workshop areas, and the four changing rooms opened up into a large multi-use social space. Funding for the development of the building would be sought from The National Lottery Community Action grant.
